SUSTAINABILITY POLICY STATEMENT

The IPCC Special Report on Global Warming of 1.5 °C identified cycling as a pathway to ensuring a safe and sustainable world for everyone, both now, and in the future. As the world governing body for cycling, the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) is committed to enabling this transition by reducing the impact of its operations on the environment, collaborating with stakeholders to achieve significant changes within the sport, and contributing to global sustainability. This document sets out a framework for developing future objectives, consistent with the UCI Sustainability Strategy.

UCI VISION FOR SUSTAINABILITY

Make cycling one of the world's most sustainable sports and promote the bicycle as a key transport mode in combating climate change, improving population health and building a more sustainable future for all.

UCI COMMITMENT TO SUSTAINABILITY

In seeking to make the sport of cycling in all its forms more sustainable, the UCI commits to:

- Uphold the five principles of the UN's Sports for Climate Action Framework:
 - Principle 1: Undertake systematic efforts to promote greater environmental responsibility
 - Principle 2: Reduce overall climate impact
 - Principle 3: Educate for climate action
 - Principle 4: Promote sustainable and responsible consumption
 - Principle 5: Advocate for climate action through communication
- Support the International Olympic Committee's Sustainability Strategy and contribute to the United Nations' 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
- Set science-based targets to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from UCI and UCI World Cycling Centre (WCC) operations.
- Assign accountability for UCI sustainability objectives to the UCI President and Management Committee.
- Integrate sustainability into UCI policies, operations, and decision-making processes.
- Engage with stakeholders from the cycling world and wider society on its sustainability objectives.
- Share best practice and become a global centre for collaboration on cycling sustainability solutions.
- Provide sustainability resources and education for its National Federations through the UCI WCC.
- Measure the UCI's environmental and social impacts, and issue an annual report communicating progress against sustainability objectives.
- Work with organisations around the world to enhance nature and biodiversity through cycling, events, and communication.
- Advocate safe cycling for everyone, everywhere, and promote strong local economies through cycling and sustainable development.

In relation to this policy, the UCI will ensure:

- It is made publicly available,
- Is implemented at all levels in the organisation, and,
- Reviewed on an annual basis.
