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










MAP OF IMOLA, EMILIA-ROMAGNA




ACCESS TO MAIN START-FINISH VENUE




MAIN FINISH VENUE - SECURITY ZONE

INFORMATION ABOUT RACE VEHICLES

VEHICLES ALLOCATED TO NATIONAL FEDERATIONS

Given the exceptional circumstances, vehicles for the 2020 UCI Road World Championships will not be provided by the organiser. National Federations are allowed to use their own vehicles to follow the Time Trial races and the Road Races.

During the Road Races, only 1 vehicle per nation is allowed in the race convoy in the following order:

- 1. vehicles of nations entering eight riders and more;
- vehicles of nations entering between six and seven riders:
- 3. vehicles of nations entering fewer than six riders grouped according to the number of riders entered.
- 4. A maximum of 25 nations' vehicles will be allowed in the race convoy. However, depending on the number of riders/countries without a team vehicle in the race convoy, we may add additional vehicles. The groupings of nations will be communicated by the UCI after the confirmation of the starters.
- 5. For the individual riders who will not have team vehicle in the race convoy, a neutral assistance will be provided. The vehicles must be in perfect technical condition. Each National Federation is responsible for the technical conformity of the vehicle(s) it uses for the event.

For nations unable to come to the event with their own vehicles, the organiser suggests the following rental service:

- SUZUKI VITARA or SUZUKI S-CROSS (according to the available models)
- From Tuesday 22 September to Sunday 27 September
- Fixed price 450€ all taxes included
- On these vehicles, the UCI will provide free of charge and will install a roof rack for nine bicycles.

As the number of vehicles is limited, any request of car rental and roof rack installation has to be transmitted to the following address: Marina.zancan@gmail.com; phone: +39 333 330 3160, as soon as possible and before 17 September 2020 at the very latest.

All drivers representing National Federations in the race convoy at UCI Road World Championships must have a UCI licence issued by a National Federation and must respect the UCI Regulations as well as the current Guidelines for vehicle circulation in the race convoy. The UCI licence must include the necessary third-party liability insurance in case of material damage or injury to others, which must be valid in all countries where the licence-holder is likely to perform his/her duties. Drivers are required to have an in-depth knowledge of cycle racing and its regulations as well as the experience and ability to anticipate a wide range of race situations. It is responsibility of the National Federation to ensure that their drivers have the necessary experience to drive in the race convoy at the UCI Road World Championships. Drivers are responsible for the manner in which they drive; if they fail to observe the regulations, they face significant financial penalties as well as the suspension

of their UCI licence (as a driver and any other role they may have). The sanctions related to driving in the race convoy are defined by articles 2.2.038 and subsequent of the UCI Regulations.

SAFE DRIVING

Safety for all of the riders, race support personnel and spectators during the race is the number one priority when operating a motor vehicle in the race convoy. Here is a summary of the main driving gui¬delines and regulations to follow and respect during the UCI Road World Championships in Imola, Emilia-Romagna.

- Have a valid a UCI license for the 2020 season (including third-party liability insurance)
- Obligation to respect UCI Regulations and Guidelines for vehicle circulation in the race convoy
- Each driver must focus on one thing: driving the vehicle in a responsible manner! It is recommended that the Sport Director or the National Team Coach in charge consider being the passenger and an experience driver focus on driving the vehicle exclusively.

MEDICAL SERVICE ON COMPETITION VENUES

Medical Center for athletes (located in a box near the start of the race)

- Opens one hour before and one hour after every race
- The Medical center is equipped with all necessary first aid equipment

In the event of injury during the races, athletes will be treated in the ambulance or, for non-emergent cases, at the Medical Center. In cases of emergency, the ambulance will transfer the patient to the nearest hospital on the route. In case of major trauma the transport will be through helicopter emergency medical services to Ospedale Maggiore, the regional trauma center.

In case of emergency occurring to the spectators, 3 ambulances are at disposition in the Autodrome of Imola calling the 118.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS - ALL EVENTS

ARTICLE 1 ORGANISATION AND APPLICABLE REGULATIONS

The 2020 UCI Road World Championships will be organised under the Regulations of the Union Cycliste Internationale, and in particular:

- Part 1 Chapter III: Equipment
- Part 2 Road Races
- Part 9 World Championships
- Part 12 Discipline and Procedures

The Union Cycliste Internationale has entrusted the organisation of the 2020 UCI Road World Championships to: Imola, Emilia-Romagna – Communication Clinic

The 2020 UCI Road World Championships will be held from Thursday 24 to Sunday 27 September 2020.

ARTICLE 2 RACE HEADQUARTERS, ACCREDITATION CENTRE, AND PRESS CENTRE

The accreditation centre is located at the Teatro Communale dell'Osservanza, Via Venturini 18, Imola. The race headquarters and the Press centre are located at: Autodromo Internazionale Enzo et Dino Ferrari, Piazza Ayrton Senna da Silva, 1,40026 Imola.

ARTICLE 3 RADIO TOUR

The Radio Tour Frequency will be 149.850 Mhz.

ARTICLE 4 NEUTRAL SERVICE

Neutral service will be provided by SHIMANO with 5 cars and 3 motorbikes.

ARTICLE 5 TRANSPONDERS AND GPS

TRANSPONDERS

Transponders will be distributed together with race numbers. Team assistants must return them after each event to SWISS TIMING assistance located on the team parking.

GPS

GPS holders are to be fixed under the bicycle saddle for road races and will be distributed together with race numbers. The GPS units will be issued to each team before the start of each road race on the team parking and team assistants must return them after each event to SWISS TIMING assistance located on the team parking.

Attention: National Federations will be invoiced for any equipment that is not returned (€100 for a transponder and €500 for a GPS unit).

ARTICLE 6 ANTI-DOPING

The UCI Anti-Doping Rules apply in their entirety. Furthermore, the anti-doping legislation of Italy applies in accordance with the prevailing national laws.

ARTICLE 7 **PENALTIES**

The UCI scale of penalties will solely apply.

ARTICLE 8 EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING

DISC BRAKES

The use of disc brakes is allowed by all riders during all the events.

JERSEYS AND DISTINCTIVE SIGNS

It is compulsory for all riders to wear their national team clothing (identical jersey and shorts for all riders).

World, Continental and National Champions must wear national team clothing that does not feature any distinctive bands on the sleeves or shorts.

Furthermore, as the World title is at stake, it is strictly forbidden for any rider to use not only the UCI World Champion's jersey but also rainbow bands on a bicycle or clothing during the UCI Road World Championships.

The sport directors of national teams must submit their national jersey and shorts to the Commissaires' Panel for approval during the confirmation of starters. They must describe the panels on the clothing approved by the National Federation for the use of each rider's sponsors.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS - ALL EVENTS

ARTICLE 9 PODIUM CEREMONIES

All podium ceremonies will take place immediately after the finish of the event. The organisation will provide an escort to guide the riders to the podium ceremony area without delay.

The UCI World Champion and the second and third-placed riders must present themselves for the podium ceremony within 10 minutes of the finish of the event.

Riders must present themselves in race clothing, wearing their national jersey and shall not wear a cap, headband, glasses or any other accessory until they leave the podium ceremony area. Due to the pandemic Covid-19, riders must weir a face mask into the podium ceremony dedicated space and also on the podium.

ARTICLE 10 DISTRIBUTION OF COMMUNIQUES AND RESULTS

Results will be available on the UCI Website (https://www.uci.org/road/events/uci-road-world-championships) after each race and communiques will be sent by email to the sport directors of each team.

ARTICLE 11 PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded at the 2020 UCI Road World Championships:





COURSE - WOMEN AND MEN INDIVIDUAL TIME TRIAL




PROFILE - WOMEN AND MEN INDIVIDUAL TIME TRIAL







ARTICLE 4 START ORDER

The riders shall start at identical intervals; the riders' start order is drawn up by the UCI and communicated after the confirmation of starters.

ARTICLE 5 FOUIPMENT CHECK

Riders must attend the equipment check at least 15 minutes before their start time. All bikes will be checked using a measuring jig that complies with UCI Regulations. 
PROFILE - WOMEN ROAD RACE




PROFILE - MEN ROAD RACE



PROFILE 1ST & 2ND CLIMB AND LAST 3KM WOMEN AND MEN ROAD RACE











ARTICLE 4 TECHNICAL SERVICE AND FEEDING ZONES

Wastes zones will be located 200 metres before and after the main feed zone on the Autodromo Enzo and Dino Ferrari. Riders must respect the environment and use the wastes zones.

Teams can carry out technical assistance and change wheels and bikes at the team pits provided for this purpose.

Feeding will be also authorised from the Team's vehicle in accordance to the UCI regulations.

ARTICLE 5 FOLLOWING VEHICLES

Sport directors will be allowed to provide technical assistance from their team vehicles in accordance with the following arrangements:

WOMEN ELITE

Each nation is allowed one vehicle in the race convoy, in the following order:

- The vehicles of nations with six or more riders in their team;
- 2. The vehicles of nations with fewer than six riders, arranged in descending order by the number of riders entered
- 3. A maximum of 25 Team vehicles will be authorized in the race convoy. The groupings of nations will be communicated by the UCI after the riders' confirmation
- For those Individual riders who will not have a team vehicle in the race convoy, Neutral support will be provided.

Within each group, the order is determined by the most recently published Elite and Under 23 Women's UCI World ranking by nation. For vehicles representing more than one nation, the best-placed nation is taken into account.

MEN ELITE

Each nation is allowed one vehicle in the race convoy, in the following order:

- The vehicles of nations with six or more riders in their team;
- 2. The vehicles of nations with fewer than six riders, arranged in descending order by the number of riders entered
- A maximum of 25 Team vehicles will be authorized in the race convoy. The groupings of nations will be communicated by the UCI after the riders' confirmation
- 4. For those Individual riders who will not have a team vehicle in the race convoy, Neutral support will be provided.

In each group, the order is determined by the most recently published Elite and Under 23 Men's UCI World Ranking by nation. For vehicles representing more than one nation, the best-placed nation on the ranking is taken into account.

ARTICLE 6 TIME LIMITS

Riders on the circuit that are about to be lapped will be stopped on the finish line.

ARTICLE 7 PODIUM CEREMONY

The first, second and third-placed riders in the race must attend the podium ceremony at the latest 10 minutes after the first rider has crossed the finish line.

Sport directors shall inform the riders and team assistants of these arrangements.

SANITARY PROTOCOL - COVID-19 PROCEDURE

The general principle of the sanitary protocol put in place for the UCI Road World Championships is that of isolation "bubbles". In accordance with this theory, a group of people (riders, staff members, technical staff, etc.) enter a secured environment for the preservation of contacts with people outside their group. Before entering this bubble, these people are Covid-tested to verify that they are not carrying the coronavirus, and during their stay in this bubble they behave in a way that allows them to avoid any prolonged contact with people outside their group.

Everyone present at the event site will be assigned in bubbles with varying levels of protection (see Figure). The teams, riders and support staff will be integrated into a bubble 1 with a maximum level of protection and a minimum level of interaction with the environment.

SANITARY PROTOCOL - COVID-19 PROCEDURE

GENERAL MEASURES

General measures will be applied to all people on the site, regardless of their bubble, namely:

Face masks must be worn at all times at the event venue, except for riders during training, warming up and racing. Any person at the event venue who is seen to be without a mask for an extended period will have their accreditation removed.

Social distancing of minimum 1.5m is expected at all times. Keep in mind that face masks on their own cannot provide complete protection against infection, and there is a need to use them alongside maintaining physical distance.

 Regular hand washing/sanitizing is expected. Hand sanitizer will be provided at multiple locations on the event area.

Specific measures will be applied to the teams (riders and staff members) and to people involved in the organisation. For riders and team members, two (2) negative viral diagnostic tests are mandatory (using a PCR technique), on D-6 and D-3 before their arrival on site, that is to say before entering the "Team Bubble".

For riders returning from the Giro's Italia Femminile, and riders returning from the Tour de France, only one PCR test at D-3 before their arrival on site is required.

APPLICATION OF THE COVID TESTS

The nature of the tests must comply with the UCI specifications as defined in the document available on the UCI website "Emergency rules to be followed for the resumption of the road cycling season in the context of the coronavirus pandemic", in Chapter III, paragraph B-1. Teams can perform these tests in a laboratory of their choice. They can also benefit from:

- The services of a UCI partner laboratory located within the University of Liège (BEL). This laboratory performs analyses in accordance with international rules and our requirements (PCR method), but on saliva. The laboratory can provide you with saliva collection kits by postal mail and to which you can return your kits by postal mail as well. To manage the logistics, please contact: Gwenaëlle Ancia (gwenaelle.ancia@uliege.be)
- The on-site laboratory made available by the Local Organising Committee: a PCR test facility will be available inside the Autodrome of Imola to collect the samples on the 21 September (3 days before the start of the women's competition) and on the 22 September (3 days before the start of men's competition).

In order to offer this kind of service the Organising Committee will need to know several days in advance the personal details of the people (athletes and staff) requiring the test, including:

 an Excel file with name/surname/date of birth/mail and contact number as well as the date of the test (21 vs 22 September) this information must be sent before Friday 18 at 12:00 noon CET using an Excel file to the following email address: liaboli@hotmail.com with the subject "PCR facility in Imola name of the team". If the request is sent after this time, the Organising Committee cannot guarantee that the test will be carried out.

RESULT COMPILATION

People tested or physicians will receive the results directly. The results must then be compiled in an Excel file available on the <u>UCI website</u> by clicking on « PCR test results ». The complete Excel sheet must be uploaded onto the <u>dedicated platform</u> (password: ImolaWC) to be checked by the UCI Medical Director.

The results and documents delivered by the laboratories must be kept individually so that they can be presented if necessary. Please note that **only the Excel file must be sent, no other document must be uploaded**.
