

## Round # 4 – TISSOT UCI Track Cycling World Cup - 6 – 8 December 2019

### GENERAL INFORMATION

Cycling New Zealand welcomes National Federation and UCI Registered teams to the fourth round of the 2020 TISSOT UCI Track Cycling World Cup which is to be held at the Avantidrome in Cambridge, New Zealand.

Cambridge is a town of approximately 20,000 people in the agricultural heart of New Zealand. It is approximately a 25-minute drive to Hamilton, the nearest city. Cambridge prides itself as being the 'Home of Champions' as it hosts the National Sport Organisations for cycling, rowing, canoe racing and triathlon as well as many major sporting events. The surrounding area supports a thriving dairy industry and world-renowned thoroughbred horse breeding farms and racing horse trainers.

The Avantidrome is the home of Cycling New Zealand and its High Performance programme. It houses a 250m, Siberian Spruce track built in 2014.

#### How to get to the venue

Nearest International airport: Auckland International airport is 134km from the velodrome. It takes approximately 2 hours to drive from the airport to Cambridge.

Nearest Domestic airport: Hamilton airport is 38 minutes flight time from Auckland airport. To drive from Hamilton airport to the velodrome takes about 20 minutes. The size of the planes between Auckland and Hamilton are small so equipment carrying capacity would be restricted.

### TRAINING SESSIONS

The competition velodrome (Avantidrome) will be available for training from Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> – Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2019. Training schedules will be distributed once all teams have confirmed their arrival details.

#### Training Venue – prior to Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December

We welcome teams to arrive early to base themselves in Cambridge for pre-event training on the competition track at the Avantidrome.

Track bookings prior to Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December can be made directly through the Avantidrome by contacting the venue by emailing [colin.dixon@avantidrome.nz](mailto:colin.dixon@avantidrome.nz). Track use during this time will have no medical provision and limited to 3 hours per day, per team. It also may be on a shared basis. Track hire fees apply and teams will be invoiced prior to arrival.
