GENERAL INFORMATION

The Anna Meares Velodrome, the home of track cycling in Brisbane, Queensland. The Velodrome was designed by COX Architects in Queensland and opened in November 2016. Purposely built for the 2018 Commonwealth Games, the stadium can house up to 1500 spectator, and expand to accommodate a further 2000 spectators. There are several events held at the Anna Meares Velodrome throughout the year including Track National Championships, Queensland National Championships, as well as Cycling Queensland Club's Events.
