Secretary Modification in the entry list

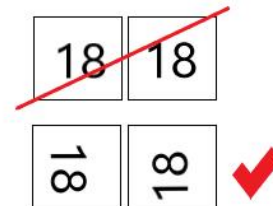
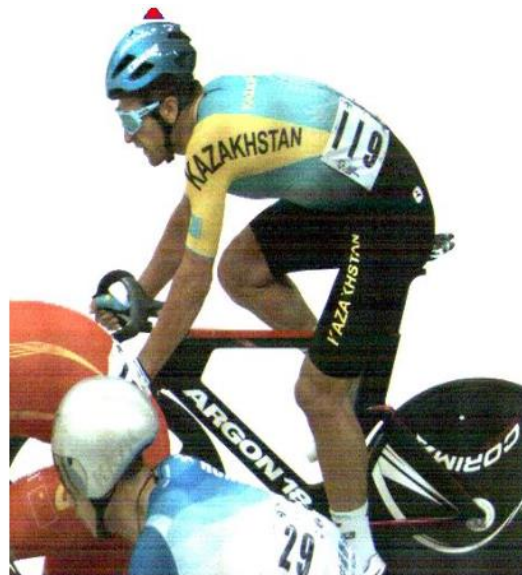
- Team Managers may change the entered rider until the start of the first competition session on the day of each event
- Team pursuit : **30min** max before start of the round
- Team sprint : **30min** max before start of the round

- Shall bring the replacement form to the Secretary of College of Commissaires

- After that, it is still possible to replace an unfit rider for medical reasons → with a medical certificate provided **by the UCI Official Doctor**
 - ☝ **The rider is declared unfit for a minimum of 48 hours (starting from the time of the specific race)**

Competition Schedule

- Daily Schedule will be displayed in the infield (distributed upon request)
- **Update qualification heats in:**
 - Wednesday: Women Scratch Race: 25 riders / 2 heats of 13 and 12 (2x 10 qualified)
 - Thursday: Men Scratch Race: 40 riders / 2 heats of 20 (2x 12 qualified)
 - Thursday: Women Elimination : Scratch 26 riders / 2 heats of 13 (2x11 qualified)
 - Friday: Men Points Race: 32 riders / 2 heats of 16 (2x 12 qualified)
 - Friday: Women Omnium: Points Race 25 riders / 2 heats of 13 and 12 (2x 10 qualified)
 - Saturday: Women Points Race: 20 riders / **no qualification heats**
 - Saturday: Men Omnium: Points Race 32 riders / 2 heats of 16 (2x 12 qualified)
 - Sunday: Women Madison: 12 teams / **no qualification heats**
 - Sunday: Men Madison: 16 teams / **no qualification heats**
 - Sunday: Men Elimination : Scratch 32 riders / 2 heats of 16 (2x12 qualified)

- Pre-check of bikes → one hour before the competitions start
- Checking of bikes → 15 min prior to the start of each session of competition
- 1 jig for the bike check → come early for mass events
- **Reminder:**
 - No modification is allowed on any material or equipment (see art. 1.3.002 and 1.3.004)
 - Checking after the race if changing the bike
 - Tinted visors: not permitted in the waiting area (3.2.003)

– Team Pursuit

1st Round: no relay if the **red flag** is shown, **and whistle**

3.2.086 In the last two heats of the first competition round, if one team catches the other, the catching team is declared the winner and shall stop as soon as possible in order to allow the other team to finish the distance and thus to record a time. In this case, if one or both teams catch their opponents, the times from the qualifying round shall be used to determine which of the two teams shall finish in the home straight.

During the finals, if one team is caught by the other, the race is over, and the catching team shall be declared the winner.

In both situations above, a pistol shot marks the end of the race at the moment on which the team crosses its finish line at the full distance or at the moment on which one team catches the other.

- **Start list order** as shown on the start list communiqué must be respected (including for Madison)

- **Team Sprint:** 3 pads 5m, 10m, 15m from the pursuit line
 - Women : Qualifying : 6 teams
 - 1st round : 3rd Q time vs 4th Q time
 - 2nd Q time vs 5th Q time
 - 1st Q time vs 6th Q time
 - 3 winners qualified for finals : 2 fastest for Gold, 3rd time for Bronze
 - The fastest of the losers for Bronze

- **Keirin:** Men : 39 riders (6 heats) / Women: 26 riders (4 heats)

- **Madison:**
 - during the neutralised lap, the second group of riders must remain motionless
 - if 1 team-mate crashes, the other has to take the position immediately
 - if 2 team-mates crash together, 5 laps neutralisation (art. 3.2.020bis)

- **Mass start events:** rider(s) overtaken by the bunch must stop immediately and will be ranked last or at the last position available

- **Elimination Race:** NO LED devices / green flag if no rider is eliminated

- **Omnium (Scratch):** rider(s) allowed to lose one lap ; second lap lost means stoppage immediately and ranking last position available & – 40 points

Material in the infield

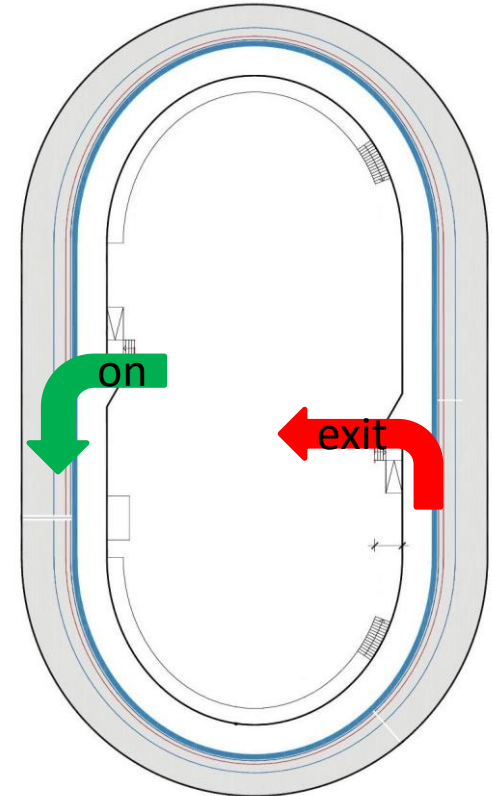
- Team Managers are not allowed on the safety zone (except for timed events)
 - You can stand in the middle of the infield / or in the grandstands corner 3 and 4

- In the infield, please keep the walkway from home straight to back straight clear

- No material in front of track doors

Track flow

- In all events (except for timed events), the riders shall enter the track on the home straight
- **All riders, including winners, must exit the track on the back straight (3 laps to go down)**



- The World Champion, the 2nd and the 3rd placed riders **shall be ready on due time** for the official ceremony. Rider → no headband, no glasses, national uniform
- For team events, the additional reserve rider will be allowed on the podium.
- PROCESS : Riders come on the podium with medals and jersey on and with MASKS ON. They should keep masks at all time.

After the World Championships

→ Approval of World Champions jersey

- The right to the rainbow colours remains the exclusive property of the UCI, including the design of the World Champion's jersey. Strict rules must be observed in the manufacture of your World Champion's jersey.
- It is thus compulsory to have the jersey and other equipment using the rainbow colours **approved by the UCI prior to manufacture**, otherwise severe penalties may be imposed (art. 1.3.072). The **designs** must be sent to the **UCI Track Department for approval via the following e-mail address: track@uci.ch**

- First aid room on the ground floor and medical team in the infield available during trainings and competitions' sessions
- If a rider is unfit to race
 - it is necessary to contact the UCI Medical Delegate for confirmation of the medical issue
 - a medical certificate valid for a minimum of 48 hours (rider is declared unfit for that period) will be sent to the PCP.
- Emergency medical care, available 24/24: 112

- ✓ **ITA Doping Control Officers : Mr. Ingo-Sven LINKE (GER) +33 7 56 19 51 82**
- ✓ **& Jaroslaw GARGOL (POL) +48 693 615 551**
- ✓ The controls will be conducted under 2021 UCI Anti-Doping Rules & IT procedures/instructions
- ✓ Location of the Doping Control Station (DCS): located in the velodrome, please follow the signposts
- ✓ When applicable, list displayed at the finish line & DCS
- ✓ Riders will be notified by chaperons, if no chaperons present, it is the riders responsibility to check if he/she has been selected for the control.
- ✓ Notification will be made orally only, written notification will be finalized with the DCO at the DCS
- ✓ Riders must report ASAP and at the latest within 30min of finishing the race or within 30 min of the end of the ceremony or press conference if applicable.

Team Managers' Meeting

- ✓ It is recommended that athletes present themselves at the DCS alone. But at most they may be accompanied by only one person.
- ✓ Representative for -18
- ✓ Must bring identification document (with photo)
- ✓ Riders must wear a face mask to come to the DCS and disinfect their hands when entering
- ✓ No shower or toilet before the test
- ✓ Any changes related to accommodation must be reported ASAP
- ✓ Nations should look in their hotel for a potential room where controls could be conducted
- ✓ Nations should ask their hotel not to prevent entrance to DCOs
