

## **Information Bulletin 2020 UCI Cycle-ball World Cup**

### **Registrations:**

National Federations have to register their clubs/teams with the UCI by e-mail using the dedicated forms until:

### **Athletes:**

The athletes will be entered after registration via their National Federation.

### **Participants quotas:**

All Elite teams are authorized to take the start, according to the following quotas set-up:

#### **European Teams**

3 Teams/nation: AUT, SUI, GER, CZE (12 legs/nation)

2 Teams/nation: FRA (6 legs)

All other nations: 1 team each

Quotas will depend on number of subscribing teams after the receipts of all applications.  
The organizing club additionally receives a wild card.

Each nation must register a substitute team. This team can only participate, if one of the officially registered teams drops out.

If a player drops out on short notice (illness / injury), a substitute from the same club who has not been registered for the World Cup may replace him.

Each team can only take part in a maximum of 4 UCI Cycle-ball World Cup tournaments.

### **Quota allocation - Tournament in non-European country**

*The ranking of the 2019 UEC European Championships U23 - Cycle-Ball will be taken in consideration for the quota allocation. Teams will be contacted separately for the participation in the Asian leg of the 2020 UCI Cycle-ball World Cup. A maximum of 2 teams are allowed to participate. The UCI will support the 2 teams with a fixed financial support for their travel. All other costs implicated must be borne by the respective teams.*

### **Wild card for U23 teams:**

Depending on the number of subscribing teams the UCI has the possibility to nominate U23 teams by giving them a wild card.

The ranking of the 2019 UEC European Championships U23 - Cycle-Ball will be taken in consideration for the quota allocation.

### **Clothing:**

All teams wear the jersey of their club. The World Champions wear the World Champion's jersey, the National Champions the National Champion's jersey and the World Cup Leader the World Cup jersey.

Please note as well the rule 1.3.071 - UCI Cycling Regulations:

Without prejudice to relevant provisions but applicable for all the disciplines, should various provisions requiring the wearing of different jerseys apply to the same rider, the order of priority shall be as follows:

1. the leader's jerseys of the stage race
  2. the world champion's jersey
  3. the leader's jersey of the cup, series or UCI classification
  4. the continental champion's jersey (not mandatory as per 1.3.070)
  5. the national champion's jersey
  6. the national jersey

### **Commissaires:**

They will be appointed by the UCI.

The UCI will test teams of two within this competition.

### **Competitions:**

The event's program and the time schedule will be worked out together with the UCI Technical Delegate.

**Rules of the game:**

In classification, a team starts not more than 4 times. The points of these legs will be added for qualifying to the UCI World Cup Final.

The 8 best teams from Europe and 1 team from Asia are qualified for the UCI World Cup final. The organiser also receives a wild card.

**Ranking for the final:**

If two or more teams have equal points after classification, the individual results of the different legs are assessed. The team with the best rankings will be nominated for the final.

**Preliminary round:**

The preliminary rounds are organized in groups; the match allocation is made in agreement with the organizing club and the UCI Technical Delegate. Goal ratio is not taken in to account during the preliminary round.

**Evening event:**

The semi-finals and finals take place at the evening event.

The other teams play matches to determine their places in the ranking.

The matches are played on the basis of the international cycle ball rules.

**Prize money:**

Prize money as indicated in the 2020 UCI Financial Obligations.

**Awarding:**

The UCI World Cup leader receives once the UCI World Cup jersey.

If a team is again UCI World Cup leader during the season, the players won't receive further jerseys: in this case, they must wear the ones already received.

The awarding is organised for all players and commissaires in collaboration between the organiser and the Technical Delegate.

**Accommodation:**

All teams must bear their own accommodation costs. If teams need any rooms, they must contact the respective organisers sufficiently in advance of the concerned tournaments.

## **UCI - Cycle-Ball World Cup Rules**

### **Tournament mode: 10 Teams**

Each tournament will be played in 2 groups with 5 teams.

The tournament is played according to the current UCI Cycle-Ball rules.

In contrary to the previous scheme, the placement of the first round is not determined in accordance with paragraph 3.3a of the UCI Cycle-Ball Rules but, as follows:

Critical to the placement of the preliminary round are the points awarded.

If two or more teams are equal on points, the placement is determined by an internal table of the teams concerned. If in this table points and goals between teams are equal, a 4m-shooting decides on the placement.

The two first teams from each group contest crosswise the semi-finals.

The winners of the semi-finals play for the title.

The losers of the semi-finals play for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place.

The third in each of the two groups play for place 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>.

The fourth in each of the two groups play for place 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>.

The fifth in each of the two groups play for place 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>.

In case of a draw in the games at places 1 to 3, at first an extra time will be played. If there is no decision a penalty-shooting decides.

In case of a draw in the games from places 5 – 10, a 4 m - shooting decides.

### **UCI Cycle-ball World Cup Final**

The grouping for the final is according to cumulative UCI World Cup ranking:

#### **Group I**

Place 1

Place 4

Place 6

Place 8

Wild Card

#### **Group II**

Place 2

Place 3

Place 5

Place 7

Asia representative

If two teams from the same nation are qualified for the final, they will be set in different groups.

## UCI Cycle-Ball World Cup Ranking

1. Ranking list according to ranking points achieved

2. Ranking, if the number of points is equal:

If points are equal, the better ranking in the qualification legs will be considered:

i.e.:

Team A

**Team A** is leader, because it reached better ranking (Rank 1) in a leg.

3. Ranking, if points and ranking of legs are equal:

Team B

<b>1. Leg in B</b>	<b>rank 1</b>	<b>50 points</b>

**Team B** is leader as it was ranked in the same leg (Leg in B) ahead of team A.
